Beachfront Baby Wraps Instructions Guide



Step 1:
Gather the wrap at your waist with the label centered at your navel. Wrap the ends around your waist and cross behind you.



Now you are ready for baby!

Step 5:
Hold baby against your chest and slightly up on your shoulder, like you are burping him.

Step 6:
Keeping one hand on baby at all times, place one leg through the corresponding strap to begin to make his seat.

Step 7:
Lifting baby slightly, place his other leg through the other strap.

For newborns or infants without head control (or when baby falls asleep), pull one of the shoulder panels out and over the back of his head, leaving his face uncovered. His face should be turned inward toward your center.



Step 11:
Pull the center panel up and over baby's back & bottom. The tag should end up at baby's neck. Baby is now supported by 3 layers of fabric.

Wearing your Wrap:

Recommended for carriers you can see his is *extremely important* so that you can keep a close eye on how much water is near your baby's face. Please practice all holds over a soft surface and/or with a helper until you are confident and comfortable. If your baby starts to fuss while putting him into the carrier, get moving! Bounce, rock, walk or do any movements you would normally do while holding him to soothe him. Keep trying, but don't force it. You can always try again another time if baby gets upset. Babywearing is worth the effort!

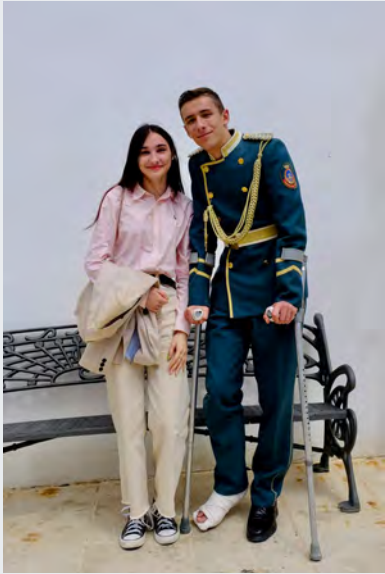
